TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. **Qualifications:** -

A. Professor

- i. An eminent scholar with Ph.D. qualification(s) in the concerned/ allied/ relevant discipline and published work of high quality, actively engaged in research with evidence of published work with a minimum of 10 publications as books and / or research / policy papers.
- ii. A minimum of ten years of teaching experience in University / College, and / or experience in research at the University / National level institutions / industries, including experience of guiding candidates for research at doctoral level.
- iii. Contribution to educational innovation, design of new curricula and courses, and technology – mediated teaching learning process.
- iv. A minimum score of 400 from Categories-II & III (cumulative), as stipulated in the Academic Performance Indicator (API) based performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS), set out in UGC Regulation, 2010 and subsequently amended in 2016.

OR

An outstanding professional with established reputation in the relevant field, who has made significant contributions to the knowledge in the concerned /allied / relevant discipline, to be substantiated by credentials.

B. Associate Professor

- i. Good academic record with a Ph.D. in the concerned/allied/relevant disciplines.
- ii. A Master's Degree with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed)
- iii. A minimum of eight years of experience of teaching and/or research in an academic/research position equivalent to that of Assistant Professor in a university, college or Accredited Research Institution/industry excluding the period of Ph.D. research with evidence of published work and a minimum of 5 publications as books and/or research/ policy papers.
However, as per the UGC clarification letter No. F.17-8/2013(PS) dated 01. 03. 2016 the period of active service spent on pursuing research degree i.e. for acquiring Ph.D. degree simultaneously without any kind of leave will be counted as teaching experience.
- iv. Contribution to educational innovation, design of new curricula and courses, and technology – mediated teaching learning process with evidence of having guided doctoral candidates and research students (evidence that at least one student obtained Ph.D. under the guidance to be submitted)
- v. A minimum score of 300 from Categories-II & III (cumulative), as stipulated in the Academic Performance Indicator (API) based performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS), set out in UGC Regulation, 2010 and subsequently amended in 2016.

C. Assistant Professor

Good academic record with at least 55% of the marks at Master's degree level or any equivalent Grade of 'B' in the seven-point scale with letter grades O, A, B, C, D, E and F. Besides fulfilling the above qualification, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR for the respective / allied subjects.

- (a) The Ph.D. degree holders registered prior to UGC Regulation 2009 and as per amended UGC Regulation 2016 and so adopted by the University shall be exempted from NET for recruitment subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:

- (1) Ph.D. degree of the candidate awarded in regular mode only;
 - (2) Evaluation of the thesis by at least two external examiners;
 - (3) Open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate had been conducted;
 - (4) Candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work out of which at least one must be in a refereed journal;
 - (5) Candidate has made at least two presentations in conference/seminar, based on his/her Ph.D. work.
- (1) to (5) as above are to be certified by the Vice-Chancellor/ Pro-Vice-Chancellor/ Dean/ Controller of Examinations.

(b) For Assistant Professor in Business Management.

I. Essential Qualification:

- (a) First Class Master's Degree in Business Management/Administration/ in a relevant management related discipline or first class in two-year full time PGDM declared equivalent by AIU/ accredited by the AICTE/UGC.

OR

- (b) First Class graduate and professionally qualified chartered Accountant/ Cost and Works Accountant/ Company Secretary of the concerned statutory bodies.

(c) Desirable:

- (a) Teaching, research, industrial and/or professional experience in reputed organizations;
- (b) Papers presented at Conferences and/or published in refereed journals.

2. Relaxation of Marks:

- i. A relaxation of 5% will be provided at the Graduate and Master's level for the SC/ST/Differently-able (Physically and Visually Handicapped)/other backward classes (non-creamy layer) candidates for the purpose of eligibility of educational qualification and for assessing good academic record during direct recruitment to teaching positions. Similarly, candidates having Ph.D. degree and those who have passed their Master's degree prior to 19-09-1991 will also be given a relaxation of 5% marks at the Master's degree, i.e. from 55% to 50%.

4. HOW TO APPLY:-

The Authority will not be responsible for any postal delay. **The envelope containing application along with all relevant documents should be super scribed “APPLICATION FOR THE POST OF in SUBJECT”**
- (ii) Applicants may send their applications through E-Mail in the following address **info.fmuniversity@gmail.com**. However, the hardcopies along with the application fee should reach the Registrar on or before the last date.
- iii) The applicants are required to submit the DD of Rs.1000/-(Rupees one thousand) only to be drawn in any nationalized bank in favour of “**Fakir Mohan University Development Fund-II**” and payable at Balasore along with the application form. However, the SC/ST/PWD applicants will submit a draft for Rs. 500/- (Rupees five hundred) only for the purpose.

The hard copy of the applications without enclosing the requisite fees before the last date will not be considered. The dully filled in API format should be submitted along with all the relevant documents in support of the claimed API.

THE LAST DATE FOR RECEIPT OF APPLICATION FORM COMPLETE IN ALL RESPECTS IS 29th May 2018.

5. Documents to be submitted along with application forms strictly in the proforma provided with documentary evidence. (One Copy):

- (a) API Score in the prescribed format (for the post of Professor and Associate Professor).
- (b) Self- attested copies of certificates and mark sheets of examinations passed.
- (c) Candidates belonging to SC/ST/PWD category must furnish the valid certificate issued by the competent authority.
- (d) Copies of other achievements and research publications.
- (e) Forwarding of application by the employer (if employed) to be received before the date of interview.
- (f) Candidates who are in service can send their applications as advance copy in order to save delay and the forwarding of application will be followed by it.
- (g) Candidates applying for the post of Associate Professor are required to submit the reprints of five major publications for evaluation by experts.
- (h) For counting towards teaching experience: The applicant has to ensure that the essential qualification for the posts held previously in other organizations/ University/College were not lower than the qualifications (and on equivalent grade) prescribed by the UGC for Assistant Professor/Associate Professor as the case may be. The appointment should not have been as part time lecturer/ Guest Lecturer/Guest Professor, and the post should have been filled in accordance with the selection procedure laid down by the UGC / University/ State and / or Central Government. These should be mentioned in the application and documentary proof to be enclosed.

6. Other Conditions: -

- (a) Applications received incomplete in any respect are liable to be summarily rejected and no correspondence on the matter shall be entertained.
- (b) The application form duly filled in by the candidate must be supported by self-attested copies of all required documents.
- (c) Merely fulfilling the minimum qualification does not entitle a candidate to be necessarily considered or called for interview.
- (d) University reserves the right not to fill up any of the vacancies advertised if the circumstances so warrant.
- (e) Relaxation of any of the qualification may be made in exceptional cases on the recommendation of the selection committee.

- (f) Separate application is required for each post.
- (g) No TA / DA will be paid to attend the selection committee or to join the first appointment.
- (h) Canvassing in any form by or on behalf of the candidates will be considered as disqualification.
- (i) In service candidates should ensure that their CCRs/Performance Appraisal Reports of last 5 years should be received by the Registrar of the University confidentially before the date of interview failing which they will not be awarded the marks/credits towards CCRs as provided by the Statute.

CATEGORY II: PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT, CO-CURRICULAR AND EXTENSION ACTIVITIES

Based on Teachers' self-assessment, category-II API scores are proposed for professional development, co-curricular and extension activities; and related contributions. The minimum API required by the teachers for eligibility for promotion is fixed in table –II(A). A list of items and scores is given below. The self- assessment score should be based on objectively verifiable records and shall be finalized by the screening cum evaluation committee for the promotion of Assistant Professor to higher grades and selection committee for the promotion of Assistant Professor to Associate Professor and Associate Professor to Professor and for direct recruitment of Associate Professor and Professor.

The model table below gives groups of activities and API scores. University may detail the activities or, in case institutional specificities require, adjust the weightages without changing the minimum total API score required under this category.

* Wherever relevant to any specific discipline, the API score for paper in refereed journal would be augmented as follows: (i) paper with impact factor less than 1 - by 5 points; (ii) papers with impact factor between 1 and 2 by 10 points; (iii) papers with impact factor between 2 and 5 by 15 points; (iv) papers with impact factor between 5 and 10 by 20 points: (v) papers with impact factor above 10 by 25 points. The candidate has to submit documentary proof in support of the claim of impact factor of the publication. The API for joint publications shall be calculated in the following manner: Of the total score for the relevant category of publication by the concerned teacher, the First and Principal / corresponding author /supervisor / mentor would share equally 70% of the total points and the remaining 30% would be shared equally by all other authors.

The University shall identify the journals subject-wise through subject expert committees and forward the recommendations to UGC in the format prescribed by UGC for approval of the UGC Standing Committee. The journals approved from this list, by the UGC Standing Committee, shall be included in the "List of Journals" notified by the UGC. The UGC Standing Committee shall give its recommendations within 60 working days of the receipt of the list from the University. The UGC Standing Committee may also, suo-moto, recommend journals for inclusion in the "List of Journals". The clause 6.0.5 (i) will be strictly followed by the University.
