

RULES REGARDING UNIVERSITY HOSTELS

The University has two gents' hostels and four ladies' hostels in the New Campus, Nuapadhi for the students of the University. Each hostel is under the supervision of a Superintendent, and one Assistant Superintendent. For Hostel Authorities: See the Prospectus-2022-23

Hostel Admission Rules and Procedure:

- a) Students seeking admission into the hostel shall have to apply in the prescribed format to the Head of the concerned Department at the time of admission.
- b) The Office of the Warden shall distribute the hostel seats on Distance-cum-Merit basis for each subject/ department/ category, and notify the list of students to be admitted in different Hostels.
- c) The preference in admission shall be given as under:
- i. Students from outside state, and students belonging to Persons With Disability (PWD) category, and students of SC/ ST category
 - ii. Students (more than 200 KMs)
 - iii. Students (within 200 KMs)
- d) Every year 2 PhD scholars each from Male and Female students shall be given hostel accommodation. The basis of their selection would be distance from their residence to F.M. University.

Refund of money and other rules

On demand, the hostel caution money shall be refunded to each boarder deducting only 10% of the Hostel caution money towards general breakage/maintenance. If the caution money is not claimed within one year from the date of leaving the hostel, the said amount shall stand forfeited.

The Mess advance shall also be refunded to the boarders while they leave the hostel. Hostel admission fees (except caution money) once deposited is non-refundable under any circumstances. For other Rules see the Prospectus of 2022-23.

Hostel readmission:

After completion of the Academic Session (first two semesters) the willing existing boarders shall have to deposit an amount of Rs.7810/- [Rs. 10,310/- – Rs.2,500/- (Rs.1,500/- Mess Advance + Rs.1,000/- Caution Money)] towards readmission through bank challan for their stay in the hostel for the next two semesters. The process of readmission shall be notified within a week of the commencement of the 3rd Semester. In the case of Ph.D. scholars their readmission will take place each year after a gap of one year from their admission date determined by the concerned superintendents.

Guest Accommodation

Rs.25/- per day will be taken from alumni of both the (Ladies' & Gents') hostels who want to stay in the respective hostels as guest.

Rs.50/- will be charged per day per bed if a current student wishes to stay in the hostel as a guest boarder.

In both the cases, it is restricted to only fifteen days maximum if not permitted by authority on some special grounds. This is subject to availability of seats.

Minimum Meals: For each border (both in Ladies' or Gents' Hostel) 50 meals per month are compulsory.
