As per the recommendation of SRC in Zoology and subsequent approval of the Vice Chancellor, the following candidates are provisionally selected for admission/registration to Ph.D./Executive Ph.D. Programme in Zoology for the session 2023-24. They are directed to appear before the Coordinator, P.G. Department of Zoology on or before 29.06.2024 during office hours with original and self-attested copies of the following documents for verification, failing which your claim for admission will be forfeited. No extension of time for admission will be allowed. Any misinformation found on verification of original documents and detected afterwards shall lead to cancellation of selection/admission and will be treated as a cognizable offence.

**Documents required:**

- a) Dully filled-in Application form for Registration (available in the university website).
- b) University/ College leaving certificate in\*original.
- c) Three self-attested copies of recent passport size photograph.
- d) Self-attested photocopies of Mark-sheets & Certificates of all examinations passed beginning with matriculation/HSC.
- e) Migration certificate in original. (If not submitted at the time of admission, migration certificate to be submitted within two months.)
- f) Proof of qualifying UGC-CSIR-NET/GATE/SLET/INSPIRE Fellowship if any.
- g) Self-attested copies of Caste certificate/ Disability certificate, if any.
- h) Relieving order from the competent authority in case of employee. (For Ph.D. Programme only)
- i) No Objection Certificate from the employer, in case of employed.
- j) An undertaking by non-employed candidates to the effect that he/she is not employed.
- k) Two copies of revised/modified research proposal/synopsis duly signed by Candidate, Supervisor & Chairman, SRC.
- l) The following fees shall be collected from the candidates as per University Notification No. 3091, dated 30-05-2024 AND 3209 DATED 18.06.2024.
  - Rs.1,000/- towards Application form fee (Form can be downloaded from the University website) for both for Ph.D./ Executive Ph.D. programme. The fees shall be deposited in the account of F.M. University Examination Fund.
  - Rs.5,000/- towards Ph.D. registration fee (for both Ph.D./ Executive Ph.D. programme). The fees shall be deposited in the account of F.M. University Examination Fund.
  - Annual Programme fee (~~1st~~ year) of Rs.10,010/- for Ph.D. programme and Rs.15,010/-for Executive Ph.D. programme. (The fees shall be deposited in the account of the University PGR Fund.)
