- 2. The syllabus for MCOM I, II, III, IV Semester for the session 2023-24 admission Batch is approved after necessary modification/ Correction (details attached in the syllabus)
- 3. The list of paper setter, Examiners and Moderators for all Semester are approved (List attached)
- 4. The list of Board of Conducting Examiners are approved (List attached)
- 5. The BoS examined the suggestions of Coordinator IQAC and examined the following aspects and resolved as follows:
- A. The BoS has examined the attainment of Programme Outcomes (POS), Programme Specific Outcomes (PSOs) and Course outcomes (COs) of the syllabi of last batch of passed out students and found satisfactory as regards to placement and higher studies.
- B. Quality of project works / field works / internships by the previous batch passed out students was found satisfactory.

- C. The placement records of previous batch passed out students in various jobs was found satisfactory.
- D. The progression of previous batch passed out students into higher studies was found satisfactory.
- E. BoS has incorporated the necessary changes to uphold the POS, PSOs, and COs in the new Syllabi.

 - 3. M.C-3.7 (B): Financial Analysis and Valuation (FAV)
 - 4. M.C-4.3(A): Forensic Accounting and Fraud Examination(FAFE)
- I. The BoS has included employability, entrepreneurship development, skill development, elective, professional, ethics, gender, human values, environment sustainability, Value Added Courses (VAC) and Field Study / Project Work / Internship components in to the curriculum courses related courses in the syllabus.
- J. The BoS has suggested and authorised the Chairmen to ensure for introduction of add-on courses through MOOC Platform for all PG Programmes and explore the concept of Finishing School for possible introduction in PG Departments
- K. The Certificate Course on" Basics of Accounting for Business Owners" will be given for the academic session 2023-24. The duration of this Couse will be six months.
- L. The BoS has suggested that the inclusion of Plagiarism Test/Check in the PG Dissertation Project will be made mandatory from the academic session 2023-23
